Welcome parents and students to First and Second grade at Western Oklahoma Christian School, Weatherford Campus. My name is Mandi Cornelius and this is my 6th year of teaching for WOCS. I live in Weatherford with my husband, Jason, and my two sons, Jonah (6) and Ethan (1). Jason and I attend the Weatherford First Church of the Nazarene where we are active in many areas.

Thank you for allowing me the opportunity to partner with you in the education of your child. I have been called by God to teach and I take that calling very seriously. It is an honor to get to know each of my students and their parents throughout the year. Please feel free to call me or come by the school if you have any questions or concerns.

My discipline policy is fairly simple. I expect my students to obey and most of the time they live up to that expectation. If a student is misbehaving, a warning will be given. If the initial warning does not correct the problem, I may take away recess time or other classroom privileges. If correction is needed a third time, I will either send a note to the parent to be signed and returned, or I will call the parent directly.

The first Thursday of every month, we will go and sing for the residents of the Weatherford Living Center. Our first visit will be Thursday, September 4th at 2:30. These visits give our students a very important and meaningful opportunity to minister to others. All parents are welcome to come along on these visits.

In October, we will be participating in the Book-it program. More information and guidelines for that program will come later.

We will take 4 field trips throughout the year. As I schedule these field trips, I will send information home as well as sign-up sheets for parent volunteers.

Student will have several tests each week. I will include the week's test schedule in my weekly note. Most of the tests in 1st and 2nd grade do not require studying. Bible memory and Spelling tests are, however, the exception. Students should study their memory verse and spelling words each day to be successful on their weekly tests.
